The session will run at Boxmoor Trust on 9th September. Places are first come first served, and places are booked by sending in your completed application either by email or post.

The session runs from 1 - 4.15 pm and includes tea, coffee and biscuits

What is the course and who can attend?

This course is delivered **free** and covers an overview of dementia and its impact on behaviour, language and communication, and aims to empower and prepare carers for the journey ahead.

The course is for people who provide unpaid care for a person with dementia who is currently living in Hertfordshire.

The course content has been written by qualified dementia specialists who work with people with dementia for Hertfordshire Partnership Mental Health Trust. It will be facilitated by Occupational Therapists with a variety of backgrounds.

We will have resources, and information to take away on the day and equipment that you can look at such as dementia radios, telecare and phones.
