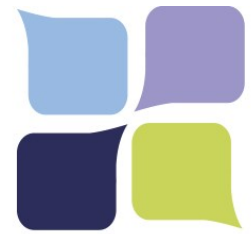


Virtual Learning Disability Carers' Forum
