Do you provide unpaid support to an adult with a learning disability?

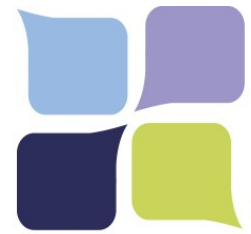
Would you like to connect with other carers and find out about local services?
