Carers in Hertfordshire has developed 16 Carer Support Hub groups across Hertfordshire. Each group needs a volunteer Leader to chair the group supported by other volunteers in the group and we are particularly looking for leaders for our Letchworth, Royston and Watford Hubs.

WHERE	You will carry out this role in your local area.
WHEN	The groups meet once a month for 2 hours at an agreed and regular time. The other hours are flexible.
ROLE	Carers in Hertfordshire are looking for confident individuals to lead Hub groups. You will help the group to agree the programme for each meeting and liaise with other volunteers between meetings. You will help the group keep to the rules it has agreed. The aim of the role is to improve support for carers locally. You will need to return records of attendance to Carers in Hertfordshire.
